Seb Humphreys is an Australian Visual Artist, based in Adelaide, known predominantly for his large scale murals work. As a Mural Artist Humphreys operates under the name 'Order 55' and is recognised internationally for his distinctive Style of transparently layered abstract paintings. He has work through out Europe and the Americas; as well as many successful projects over the last 15 years operating in major cities and rural areas throughout Australia and New Zealand.

## Public Art. Sculpture

Utilising many years of working in urban spaces has more recently lead Humphreys to key consultancy roles in off the plan projects. Operating as an 'embedded creative' in the design phase of projects and creating solutions to integrate public art into the fabric of new developments.

### George Whittle Reserve Re-Development

The George Whittle reserve project presents a multi functional - skateable - playground - public art sculpture. Representing the history and future of the area, the sculpture creatively unites natural elements (River Redgum) with an ode to the 'Redhen' railcar (fabricated locally in Adelaide from 1955-71).

Extending to nearby street furniture and public exercise equipment the artwork sets the theme of the park - exemplifying a modern approach to collaboration between Public Artist (Humphreys) - Landscape architect (JPE Design ) -and Skatepark designers (Convic Skateparks).

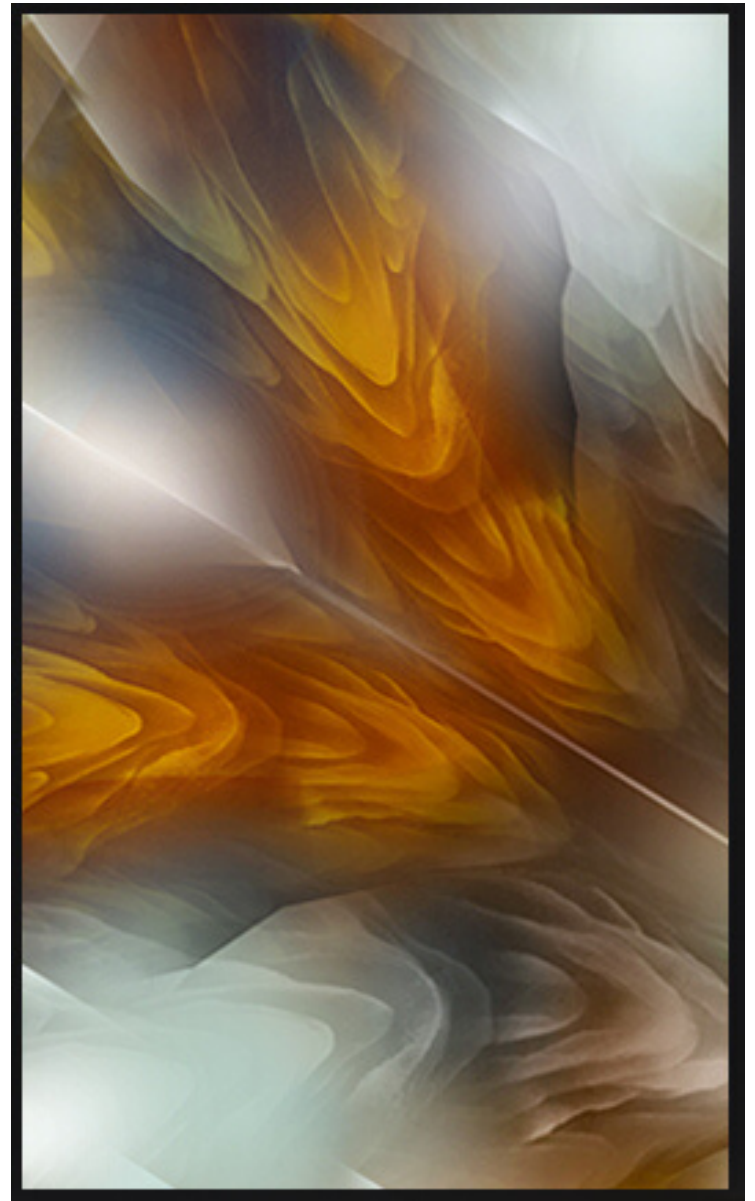
